



Activity Nr. 1	
Activity Name	Distribution of ready to eat food aids for IDPs, Salah Al-Din Province
The Donor	COOPERATIVE HOUSING FOUNDATION (CHF)
Date of the Activity	10/1/2017 to 9/2/2017
Location	Salah Al-Din Province, Tikreet District
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID distributed ready to eat food aids to IDPs in different areas of Tikreet District. Those IDPs fled from villages and areas located South Ninawa, which are near Salah Al-Din Province. Those IDPs settled in abandoned and/or unfinished buildings leaving everything behind. The distribution was in the following areas: 1. Al-Qadisiyah Complex in Tikreet, 250 food parcels. 2. Shaklawa Complex in Tikreet, 250 food parcels. 3. Tikrit Downtown area, 285 food parcels. 4. Camp Complexes in Tikreet, 250 food parcels.

Activity Name	Free legal support to minorities of Ninawa
The Donor	Heart Land Alliance (HAI)
Date of the Activity	15/2/2017 to 31/12/2017
Location	Ninawa: Mosul, Hamdaniya, Sinjar, Bashiqa, and Bartla Districts
A Brief Description of the Activity	Free legal and PSS support were provided to returnees, minorities, from Mosul, Hamdaniya, Sinjar, Bashiqa, and Bartla Districts. The beneficiaries of the project were Christians, Ezidies and Shabak.
Project Outputs	 Documenting the level of destruction of those people's properties using the GIS system. The number of cases was 243 ones. Educating the returnees and IDPs in these areas about their rights, 185 persons. Distributing booklets on public rights, 3238 copies. Distributing booklets on ownership rights, 461 copies. Providing legal services in courts and government institutions for 461 cases. Providing PSS support to returnees and IDPs in these areas for 39 cases.









Activity Nr. 3	
Activity Name	Distribution of food aids and hygiene kits to newly liberated civilians in West Mosul
The Donor	CordAid
Date of the Activity	10/5/2017 to 11/5/2017
Location	Ninawa Province, West Mosul
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID distributed 400 food parcels and hygiene kits with mineral waters to families who fled from clashes or newly liberated areas in West Mosul. IID voluntary team received and distributed aids to people at Al-Aqrab Screening Site, it is a security check point where people had to be screened and checked so as not to let any ISIL fighters run away from justice.







Activity Nr. 4	
Activity Name	Safe space centers for children and women of Mosul
The Donor	ZOA
Date of the Activity	1/5/2017 to 31/12/2017
Location	Ninawa Province, East and West Mosul
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID open four safe space community centers to provide PSS, educational support and vocational trainings. The main focus of the centers was the psychological well-being of the people and how to alleviate all the pain and suffering they went through. Also, another goal was to provide educational support to thousands of children and illiterate women who were the victims of ISIL. ISIL disrupted those children and women education and made them three years behind. Concerning vocational trainings, the safe centers opened training course in sewing, cooking, hairdressing, etc. to provide the women, especially widowed, the opportunity to run their own business and be the breed winner of the family. To get over the crisis and uproot it, the centers were keened on providing awareness lectures to the beneficiaries on peaceful coexistence, rejecting violence, tolerance, cooperation, protecting the environment and respecting human rights.
Outputs	 PSS and educational support were provided to 2110 children. PSS and educational support were provided to 1139 women.

Activity Nr. 5	
Activity Name	Building trust through dialogue between the security forces and the community
The Donor	UNDP
Date of the Activity	1/5/2017 to 31/10/2017
Location	Salah Al-Din Province, Tikreet, Shirqat and Balad Districts
	1- Three focus group sessions were conducted in Tikreet, Shirqat and Balad Districts. Fifteen participants attended each session from influential community leaders and security forces in the three areas aforementioned. In-depth discussion was raised and talked about the problems and hinders that prevent the society from communication with the security forces. Also, they discussed the ways to enhance trust and confidence between the two parties.
A Brief Description of the Activity	2- Three sessions were conducted in Tikreet, Shirqat and Balad Districts. 123 influential figures participated in those sessions. During the session there had been a debate over the relationship between the security forces and the society and what are the reasons that might prevent people from cooperation with the security forces.
	3- Organizing nine raising awareness lectures to secondary students in Tikreet, Shirqat and Balad Districts. 540 secondary students participated in the lectures. The goal was to raise their awareness and culture on the importance of community policing and the security forces in achieving stabilization and the role of youth in supporting peace through the elimination of terrorism and spreading the culture of peace and tolerance.









Activity Nr. 6	
Activity Name	Distribution of food aids to 1000 newly liberated families in West Mosul
The Donor	ZOA
Date of the Activity	8/6/2017 to 17/7/2017
Location	Ninawa Province, Mosul City, West Mosul
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID distributed 1000 food parcels to families in newly liberated areas in West Mosul. IID voluntary team distributed aids to people who were in dire need of these aids to fill their food shortage because ISIL blockaded them and their inability to access the food for more than three months. The locations were as follows: 1. On 20/6/2017, 250 food parcels were distributed in Qunaytera village. 2. On 21/6/2017, 137 food parcels were distributed in Sayramoon village. 3. On 21/6/2017, 75 food parcels were distributed in Cafor village. 4. On 7/7/2017, 280 food parcels were distributed in Tammuz Neighborhood, West Mosul.
	5. On 17/7/2017, 258 food parcels were distributed in Mesherfa 2 Neighborhood, West Mosul.

Activity Name	Distribution of ready to eat food aids to 2000 citizens in West Mosul
The Donor	ZOA
Date of the Activity	12/7/2017 to 31/7/2017
Location	Ninawa, Mosul City, West Mosul
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID distributed ready to eat food aids to 2000 citizens who fled from the clashes and ISIL-seized areas. Ready to eat food aids and mineral water were provided to the families fleeing from their areas because of the military operations. The families were in dire need to fill the food shortage they suffered because of the ISIL blockade and ISIL used them as human shields. The distribution had lasted three months and as follows: 1. On 18/7/2017, 600 food parcels were distributed in Tammuz Neighborhood, West Mosul. 2. On 23/7/2017, 650 food parcels were distributed in Zanjili Neighborhood, West Mosul. 3. On 26/7/2017, 750 food parcels were distributed in Wady Hajar Neighborhood, West Mosul.

Activity Name	Distribution of food aids to 1000 liberated families in West Mosul

Date of the Activity	9/8/2017 to 31/8/2017
Location	Ninawa, Mosul City, West Mosul, Mesherfa 1 Neighborhood
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID distributed food aids to 1000 families in Mesherfa 1 Neighborhood. Food aids were provided to those families. The families were in dire need of filling their food shortage they suffered from for more than three months. It was reported that over 17 innocent people had died of hunger and thirst because of ISIL blockade and ISIL used those innocent people as human shields.









Activity Nr. 9	
Activity Name	Establishing a women's volunteer team (Qadirat)
The Donor	Konrad Adenauer Stiftung, KAS
Date of the Activity	4/9/2017 to 15/11/2017
Location	Ninawa, Mosul City
The goal	After conducting a study on women situation in Mosul, IID had developed an action plan to form the first women's volunteer team working on women's issues after the liberation of Mosul city. The team aimed at promoting women's role in social life and creating initiatives for them to participate in the peacebuilding process and take their important role in the society.
A Brief Description of Activity 1	 Workshop 1: Women's role in peacebuilding, 3-4/11/2017: A session was held to discuss the causes of conflicts and how to resolve them. Brainstorming was applied to oreder the conflicts and then a written assignment was given in order to know their sequence. The reconciliation agreement was then explained with giving international and local examples. The participants were divided into 5 working groups and asked to submit proposals on peacebuilding projects. An explanation of the concept of advocacy and its tools was presented. Participants were divided into two groups and examples of advocacy campaigns were provided and explained.
A Brief Description of Activity 2	 Workshop 2: What we do tomorrow, 9-10/11/2017 Participants were divided into groups and asked what they know of civil society. Then, a brief history of the civil society was presented as well as its importance and legality. Explaining the relationship of volunteering with the work of non - governmental organizations, then the role of volunteerism and its association with sustainable development was explained. SWAT table on internal and external opportunities was explained as well the challenges and risks. The participants were divided into five groups, each of which analyzed the peace situation in Mosul and identified the main players to promote civil peace and how women have a major role to contribute to the promotion of civil peace. The participants were divided into 4 groups and were asked to select a name for their voluntary team. Qadirat name was agreed upon, which means "capable of" in English. Qadirat to change their reality to better and promote their situation and build permanent peace. After selecting the name, the organizational structure was detailed and agreed upon that consists of a head, follow-up groups and committee. Also, they decided to write the goal, vision and the mission of the team. In the end, three logo samples were presented that were designed by the participants themselves. After thorough discussions, one was selected putting the team name on it.





Activity Nr. 10	
Activity Name	Ninawa international marathon for peace and reconstruction
The Donor	The Reconstruction Fund of the Areas Affected by Terrorism
Date of the Activity	30/11/2017
Location	Ninawa, Mosul City
A Brief Description of the Activity	On 30/11/2018, IID contributed in organizing Ninawa International Marathon for Peace and Reconstruction with the Ministry of Youth and Sports. Iraqi security forces declared the final victory in July in the battle to oust ISIL from Mosul, but the cost was too high, many civilians were killed or injured with a very high scale of destruction. On Thursday, more than 4,000 Iraqi and foreign runners took part in a first "Ninawa International Marathon for Peace and Reconstruction" in east Mosul that kicked off near the destroyed Old Bridge in order to send a message to the international community that Mosul would rise again despite the harsh and cruel circumstances that experienced under ISIL terrorist occupation.

Activity Name	Mechanism of monitoring and reporting

Location	Ninawa, Mosul City
A Brief Description of the Activity	IID organized a workshop for 4 days from 10/12 to 13/12/2017. The workshop was entitled (Monitoring and Reporting Mechanisms). 27 IID members participated in the training to learn how to write reports, methods of monitoring results and how to write success stories in activities. Also, they were trained on the types of reports and how to write each report after the follow-up and evaluation process whose tools were explained through evaluation formats, personal interviews and/or arranging focus group to the target groups.
